An EXPLANATION of the several Characters us'd in this BOOK.

D. stands for Double. A Double is four Steps forward and backward, closing both Feet.

S. ——— Single. A Single is two Steps, closing both Feet.

Set and turn S. Is a Single to one Hand, and a Single to the other, and turn single.

Wo. stands for Woman.

We. ——— Women.

Cu. ——— Couple.

Co. ——— Contrary.

The Figure half round, is the Hey half round.

The whole Figure, is the Hey all four round.

Proper, is when the Men and Women are on their own Sides.

Improper, is when the Men are on the Womens Side, or the Women on the Mens Side.

∴ denotes the Strain of a Tune play'd once over.

∴ ——— the Strain twice over.

∴ ——— the Strain thrice over.

⊙ stands for the Mens Places, in the Figure on the Top of each Page.

⊙ ——— the Womens Places, in the Figure on the Top of each Page.
